Even before the organisation was founded in 1998, five working groups were established: Epidemiology, Diagnostics and Therapy, Social Aspects, Health Economy and Public Relations/ Medical Awareness. The groups discussed various projects and first results were published.			Patient organisation in the German speaking part of Switzerland, with several local patient group organisations. Goals: To overcome depression in all its forms. To found, support and accompany patient groups all over Switzerland. To inform patients and relatives about the disease, its course and treatment options. Equilibrium stands for modern psychiatry and psychology and also gives room to alternative treatment methods.			From 1994 - 2008, the Werner Alfred Selo Foundation supported research projects on depression, with a special focus on comorbidity with migraine. In 2008, the foundation changed its focus and has since then concentrated on raising awareness through effective public relations work. To this end it launches creative projects. The Werner Alfred Selo Foundation, Zug, grants contributions, scholarships, prizes, etc. for research into depression and headaches (comorbidity). This research may relate to the manifestations, course of the disease, the condition of those affected, treatment options and social significance of these diseases.
